Parade Route

All boats will start off from Bainbridge Marina. Once at the mouth of the Boat Basin the Pirate Ship (parade flagship) will lead the parade past the Chamber and Cheney Griffin Park.

The Pirate Ship will return to the Chamber. All return traffic should stay to the right until all parade entrants have made their initial run.

Judging will occur when your boat is beside the Chamber. Judges will rate your ... music, decorations, acts, announcements, etc. from the Bainbridge-Decatur County Chamber of Commerce lower deck.

Parade Do's and Don'ts

BE Colorful

Deck displays add a lot of variety and color that demand attention.

BE VISIBLE

Can your decorations be seen clearly? Make things BIG!

DON'T PASS OTHER BOATS OR FOLLOW TOO CLOSE

#1 boat (closest to the judges) is the boat being judged.

DON'T FORGET TO CLEARLY DISPLAY YOUR PARADE NUMBER

If we see your number as you approach, we have sufficient time to look you over.

Many bow numbers fold in half because of the wind, and are not readable.

DON'T TRAVEL AT 8+ KNOTS

By the time we see and record your number, you are gone.

GENERAL:

Parade I.D. Numbers MUST be displayed on the starboard beam and stern and for judging and identification.

DESIGN & MUSIC:

Be creative. Have fun! Pick music to fit your theme and mood. Put speakers on the starboard side facing the viewing audience.

JUDGING:

Your boat will be judged from the STARBOARD side only. Judges will be stationed at the Chamber lower deck and your boat will be judged at that site only. We expect the boat parade will draw many viewers so please continue your theme until you have passed Cheney Griffin Park.
